Community Garden

Two containers have now been received. They need to be painted and decorated.

The garden meeting took place, 18 people attended, went really well, and had lots of ideas.

Nikki needs to do garden risk assessments.

Wood has been ordered for the raised beds. There are a few volunteers to build and help with these.

Criminal justice team has done more clearing, there is a contractor clearing the fallen trees.

Location has been decided for the bee hives, nice secluded area, some concerns were discussed.

Looking for pallets, Nikki is doing a facebook post.

Poly tunnels and the delivery have been paid for.

17 people are currently on the list for raised beds the area can fit 50.

Annmarie asked if it would be an idea to have the kids paint the containers, this will all be covered under the educational partnership remit.

Adele is crocheting mushrooms for the school kids for the garden.

Community Garden Launch

There will be a soft launch on 03/05/25 for people to come along and have a look at the garden. There will be a BBQ for locals using the GrubHub funds.

SVE Consultant

Angela Watt is a free consultant through SVE.

She will be helping look into solar power and renewable energy. Is there a possibility we can put in electric car charging areas?

She is very positive about the village and has lots of good ideas.

Currently looking at a field near/ behind the Goth that has potential as a solar farm. Could it be leased, get funding from the bank?

Question was asked if wind power could be a possibility, at the moment the cost for this is very high.

It was confirmed SVE is - Stirlingshire Voluntary Enterprises and they support the third sector.

STEM

The STEM project is based at Stirling University. They are currently collaborating with the Church of Scotland and Stirling Council to provide tutoring for care experienced children. Fallin was an area that was suggested to them as a good place to work with.

They are going to attend the future destinations event at the primary school on 11/03/25.

This project will start with 4 children from the village that fall under this remit.

Surplus Food

The surplus food opportunity in Fallin started on Christmas Eve when we received lots of surplus from M&S in Dunblane.

There is now an agreement in place for donations to be received from M&S in Stirling 3 days per week.

It is run by volunteers and the food is distributed from The Goth or the community garden.

Still trial and error until all the kinks are ironed out and working out all the admin at the moment.

AGM

The AGM will take place on 25/03/2025.

Current board members will officially step down, voting will take place for new board members.

We will then have our regular monthly meeting, finished with some light refreshments.
